WARNING ORDER: NO 2 (HUTT CITY) SQUADRON – AVIATION TRAINING WEEKEND – 06-07 APRIL 19

SITUATION

1. 2SQN is running an aviation training weekend at Hood Aerodrome, Masterton to further Cadet's aviation training both in ground school and in the air.

AIM

2. The aim of this training weekend is for cadets to develop and put into practice aviation skills and concepts they have been taught through their general aviation training.

DETAILS

3. Date: Friday 05APR – Sunday 07APR19
Location: Wairarapa & Ruahine Aero Club, Hood Aerodrome, Solway, Masterton
Timings: Arrive at Unit Building NLT 1730hrs Friday.
Depart from Unit Building 1600hrs Sunday
Cost: \$10 for food plus the cost of flights.
Flights are priced at \$130 per hour, so the exact cost will vary based on how many flights you have and how long they last.
4. Joining Instructions with a kit list and further information will be available upon return of permission slips.

TRAINING

5. The weekend will consist of ground school and practical flight training in aircraft.

PERMISSION

6. A UIF10 Parent Consent form is due NLT 27 March. This can be found on the Squadron Website and should be filled in electronically and emailed to 2sqn@cadetforces.org.nz. If it is emailed from a parent's email address, this will count as signed.

MEALS

7. Cadets will need to bring lunch for both days. A fridge and kitchen facilities will be available. Dinner and breakfasts will be provided.
8. Dietary requirements should be logged on CadetNet. If you are unsure if these are correct or up to date, make a note on your consent form.

TRANSPORT

9. Transport will be provided for the weekend by fully licensed NZCF staff.

PAYMENT

10. An up-front payment of \$10 is required NLT 03APR – internet banking is preferred.
11. After the weekend, you will be invoiced for your flight costs. These will be due within one week from the date of the invoice unless organised prior with the Unit Support Committee.
